Los Cabos, Mexico (July 28, 2015) -- Ten years after its successful debut as the finest adults-only resort property in Los Cabos, <u>Pueblo Bonito Pacifica Golf & Spa Resort</u> will begin a new chapter on August 1 when it enters its second phase of development. buildings, will serve light breakfast, afternoon snacks, and pre- and after-dinner cocktails, all in a dramatic oceanfront setting.

The expected completion date of the new towers and amenities is October, 2016. During the expansion period, the latest technology will be utilized to control dust and noise. Current Pacifica services and amenities, including pools, spa, restaurants and bars, will not be impacted during the expansion.
